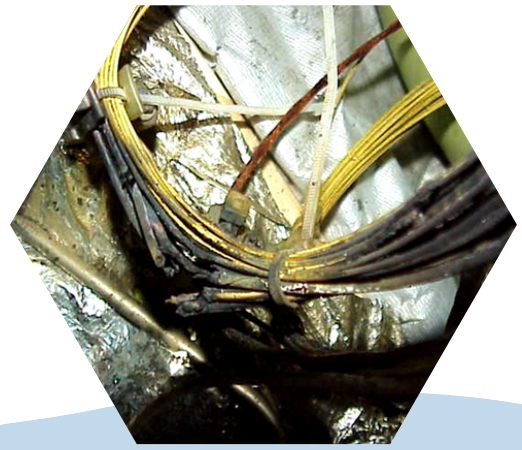

EWIS MODULE G



WHAT'S IN IT FOR YOU?

The EWIS Module G course enables the participants to demonstrate skills in the assembly and repair of harness and replacement of different connectors found in aircraft.

Through the course, the instructor lays the groundwork for:

- Safe and efficient maintenance
- Alterations and repair of aircraft EWIS

The course offers hands-on training which emphasises the proper use of tools when performing repair and replacement of connective devices.

The existing skills of participants are integrated into the course - and individual guidance will be provided.

COURSE CONTENT

To attend this course, participants must have completed the EWIS Target Group 1 - Modules A-F (which we can also provide).

Participants train the disassembly, back-shell maintenance, contact extraction & insertion, crimping, stacking assembly, torque, and strain relief of the following components:

- Circular connector
- Rectangular connectors
- Terminal blocks - Modular & Non-Modular
- Grounding modules
- Pressure seals

You will receive a certificate upon completion.

COMPLIANCE

Part-145 AMC 20-22, 145.A.30, and 145.A.35 state that maintenance staff must complete initial training and continuation training every two years.

This course ensures compliance with the requirements for the EWIS Group 1 initial practical training of Module G.

- Qualified staff performing EWIS maintenance
- Staff involved in EWIS maintenance incl.:
 - Part-21 Production staff
 - Staff performing EWIS inspections
