COMPLIANCE

Our training complies with the Danish National Aviation Safety Programme (NASP) session 13.1 which describes basic training requirements for Security Managers, deputies, and personnel with assigned security responsibilities.

This entry-level course supports the mandatory requirements stated in the NASP to obtain the required approval.

You will receive a certificate upon completion which includes passing a final test.

COURSE CONTENT

Our course covers a variety of key topics:

- Your role as a future security professional in the overall aviation security framework
- Types of threats to consider in a security risk assessment
- Steps to enforce security in your work areas
- Human factors in security management
- Situation-based communication
- Past & current threats to the aviation industry
- Aviation security regulations from national and international organisations
- Airport access control (people & vehicles)
- Security basics (passengers, baggage, cargo, mail & catering)
- Common airport & in-flight security measures for responding to threats

TARGET GROUPS

The Danish Civil Aviation and Railway Authority require that all Security Managers, deputies, and other personnel responsible for security receive formal approval according to the NASP.
